the exhibition, entitled **flux**, will open march 28 and run to april 22. the **reception** will be on friday, **march 31** from 7 to 9pm. work will be available for pick-up on sunday, april 23, from noon to 4pm.

each member of works is invited to place **one** work of art into the exhibition, your single piece must be ready-to-hang (framed/mounted with appropriate hanging hardware), and is limited to **30** inches in width **by 36** inches in height; sculpture is limited to 30 inches in width and depth and should include instructions for a pedestal or suspension if needed. please provide a resume and artist statement.

all work must be **hand-delivered** to 30 north 3rd street from tuesday, **march 14 to** saturday, **march 18** between the hours of noon and 4pm; or until 7pm thursday, march 17. no work will be accepted after 4pm march 18. the exhibition entry form and exhibition agreement can be completed when you deliver your work or can be downloaded at [www.workssanjose.com](http://www.workssanjose.com). volunteers are needed for installation—please ask how you can help!

performance artists who would like to present a work during the reception must call or email works by 4pm march 18 to reserve time and space.

**this year** we are pleased to announce that george rivera, executive director of the triton museum of art, and anjee helstrup-alvarez, associate director/curator of macla: movimiento de arte y cultura latino americana, and a works advisory board member, will be selecting two **jurors choice awards** to be announced at the opening reception.
