## body of works:

## your body of work:

bring one or more squares to the exhibition or create one on site to benefit works. *choose one or all to depict in any real, imagined, or metaphorical manner:*

**1** head and shoulders

**2** torso

**3** hip to knee

**4** knee to feet

*and produce your work:*

- in any media
- to finished size of 16x16 inches
- to lay flat to the wall—without stretcher bars or other mounts
- with 2 punched or drilled holes centered 8.5 inches apart along the top edge—equal to the 1st and 3rd holes of a 3-hole punch. bring it with holes or we can punch or drill for you.

*add your work to the wall on opening night and throughout the exhibition.*
